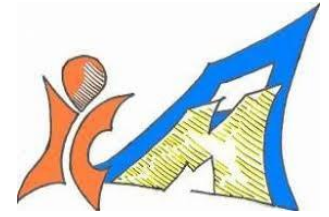

**4th Learning Teaching

TUESDAY 22nd of NOVEMBER 2022

The training ended with a discussion on the various methods and their impact on teacher-teacher and teacher-pupil relationships and their usefulness in teaching.

Certificates were issued at the end of the training by Prof. Napolitano Loredana of I.C.S. Aldo Moro to all training participants.
